Uniform The children are looking very smart but I have noticed several children who are not in the correct school uniform so I have listed the uniform below. Please make sure that all children are in the correct uniform. Uniform is available on line from “Stitch Design” and can be delivered to school free of charge. White polo shirt with school logo (girls & boys) Red crew neck sweatshirt with school logo or red cardigan with logo (girls)

Grey skirts, culottes or tailored trousers (girls) Grey tailored trousers or shorts (boys)

Black shoes (girls & boys) socks / tights should be grey or white (girls & boys)

Girls - Red check dresses (summer)

Nursery children wear grey or black jogging bottoms and trainers.
