The school will continue to employ the Specialist PE teacher to deliver modules of the PE Curriculum to all pupils throughout the school from Foundation Stage to KS2.

Additionally, we will use the funding to buy into the service provided by the Sutton Schools Sports Partnership which will entitle us to enhanced services, on-going curriculum support and additional competitive opportunities. We will continue to provide quality training for staff, after school sports activities for the pupils and purchase new sports equipment.
