

Allocation of funding 2015/16

The school will continue to employ the Specialist PE teacher to deliver the Gym and Dance modules of the PE Curriculum to all pupils throughout the school from Foundation Stage to KS2. Additionally, we are planning use part of the funding to buy into the service provided by the Sutton Schools Sports Partnership which will entitle us to enhanced services, on-going curriculum support and additional competitive opportunities. We will continue to provide quality training for staff, after school sports activities for the pupils and purchase new sports equipment.
