Dear Parents/ Carers,

As we approach the end of Trinity 2 and indeed the school year, I would like to update you on arrangements for the end of term and the start of Michaelmas 1.

We would usually like to end with a church service for the Year 6 leavers, however, during these strange times we are unable to have large gatherings. Instead, each Year 6 bubble will have its own short service in church, where only the parents of those children will be allowed to attend. I would, therefore, like to wish you all a safe and peaceful summer holiday, and I hope you have time to relax and regroup for September. I am grateful for your support and best wishes to myself and all the staff during this very difficult time. We have had to make some strange and difficult changes, that may not always suit everyone, but it has always been our intention to keep the children safe and follow our detailed risk assessment.

In September we still have to follow some of the DfE guidelines and our updated risk assessment (available on the school website). Therefore, some of the immediate changes will include inviting back the whole school to full-time education. As you are aware, we have tried to do this as much as possible beforehand, so that the children have had the chance to adapt to returning to school in preparation for this time. We will continue to stagger the start and end times of the school day in order to make it safe for everyone. Unfortunately, we are still unable to invite parents on to the school premises and will continue to use the existing 4 zones at the beginning and end of the day. Further

- snacks will be permitted – provided they are fresh fruit or vegetables, no other snacks are allowed
- named waterbottles should be provided for each child
- no masks should be worn in school
- children should not bring their own stationery/pencil cases into school
- No toys will be allowed in school
- Children in EYFS and KS1 will be permitted to bring in their school book bags and KS2 children will be allowed to bring a school rucksack available from the school uniform website

Uniform

A polite reminder that school shoes must be

- No heels
- No boots
- No trainers
- No sandals
- Black in colour

Sensible school shoes are required at all times, and if they are laced your child should be able to tie them by themselves. Otherwise, shoes with velcro ties should be purchased. All children should return to school with a full PE kit including jogging bottoms (for the colder weather) and plimsolls/trainers.

Coats must be **plain black or blue** in colour and preferably with the school logo which can be purchased from £16 from the school uniform website.

Please remember all items must be named.
