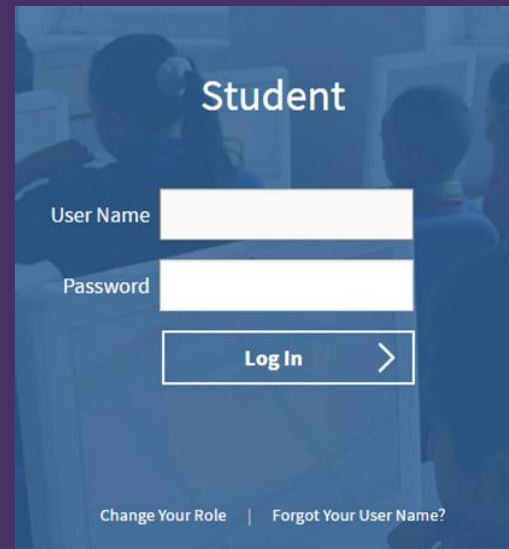
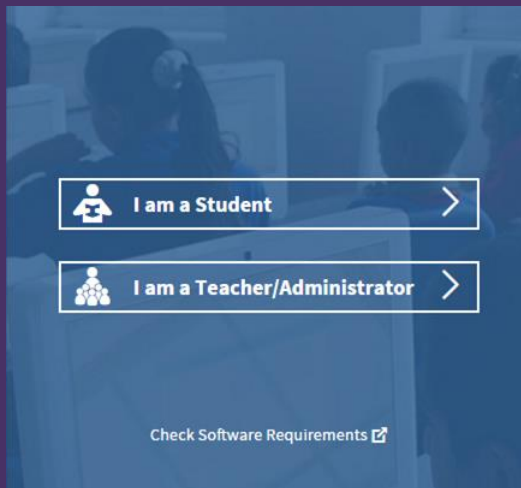
Accelerated Reading



Accelerated reading is a fun and enjoyable way for children to independently quiz themselves on their knowledge of books they have read. Every time they finish a book they are encouraged to take an AR quiz (if there is one available on the site). This should help their comprehension abilities to grow. And hopefully you will see their confidence and enjoyment in reading go up.

What the login site looks like for your children

They are encouraged to take quizzes at school. This could be when they finish an activity during a lesson, during break times or whenever the teacher sees it best fits in their schedules.



First, they click the button saying:

I am a student.

This will take them to the next page.

They use the same username/password as their LGFL email but without the @lgfl section.

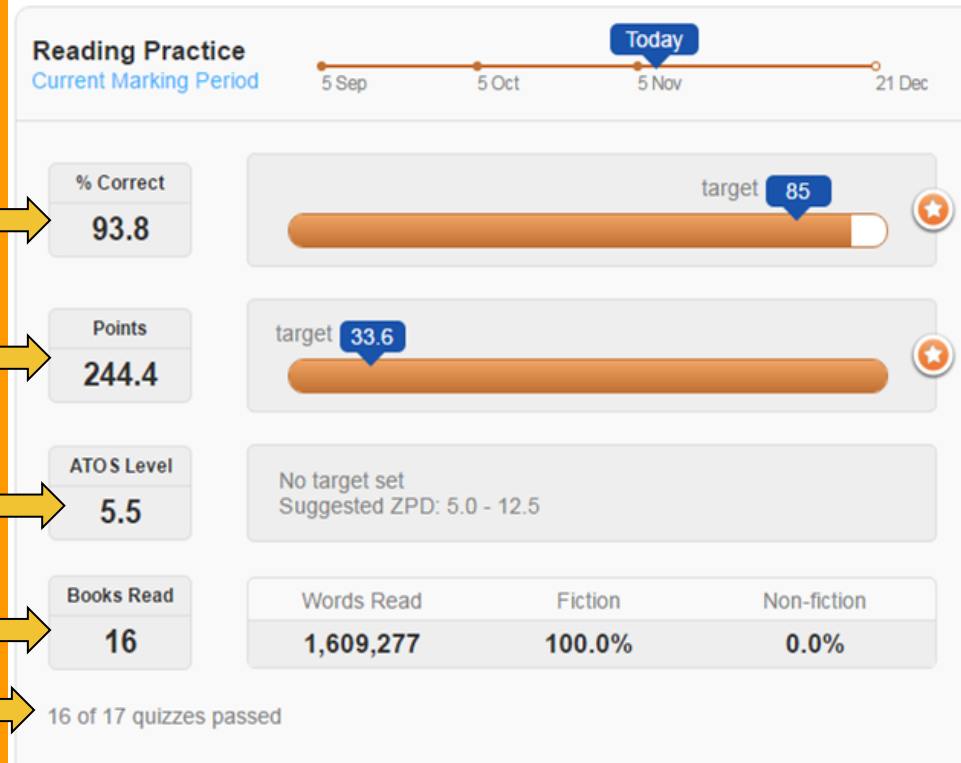

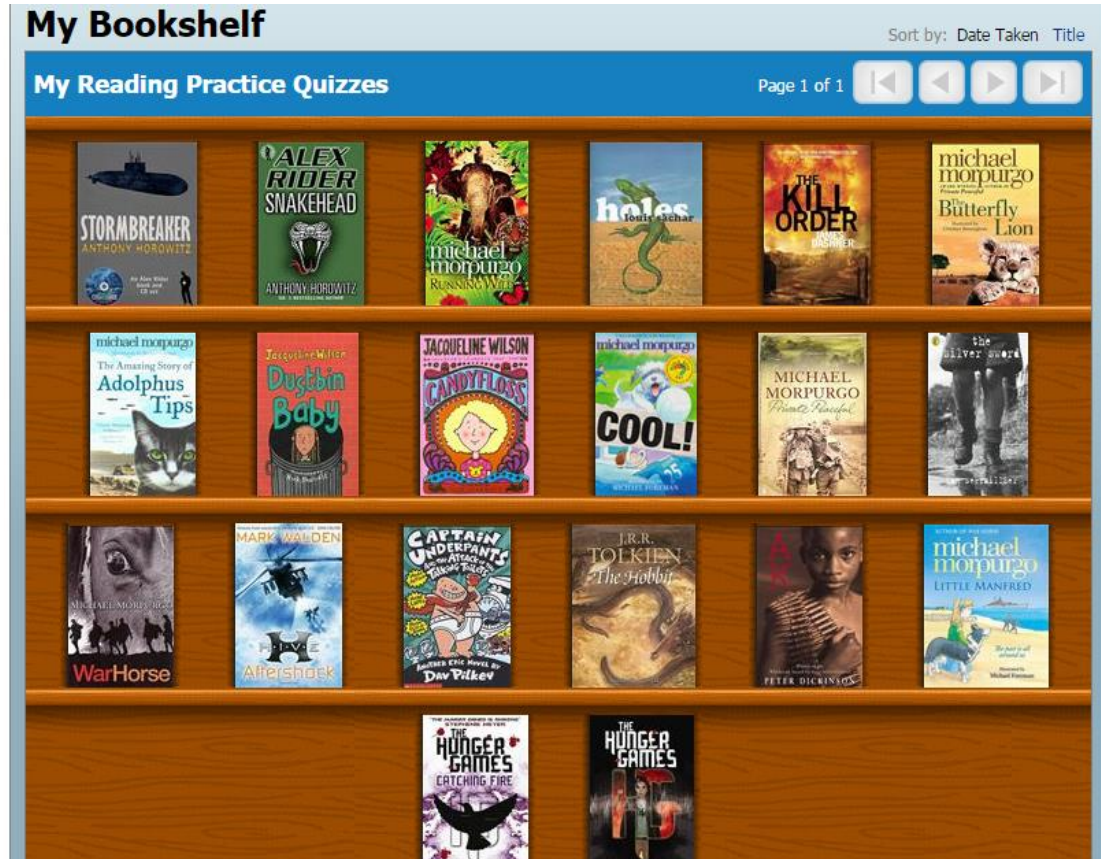
What can you do?


